## **OUR PROCESS**

Petit Verdot is a small, thick-skinned grape that when fermented into wine is high in tannins and produces a deep, red-colored wine. It is one of the six varietals of grapes that can constitute a Bordeaux Blend and is typically used to add structure to a thinner wine. Our Petit Verdot is grown in our LMP (Lanza/Musto/Pinto) Vineyard located Northwest of the winery. This region in Suisun Valley provides ideal growing conditions for this grape, with plenty of sunshine, warmth, and sufficient time to mature on the vine.

## **TASTING NOTES**

This wine boasts a rich, full-bodied texture, with complex aromas including black tea, violet, and plum. On the palate, it has a dominant dark fruit flavor with a subtle hint of licorice. The influence of American oak adds a coffee and vanilla taste. This wine will age well when properly stored and for best food pairings is well-suited with hearty, slow-cooked dishes such as beef stew or braised short ribs. We recommend decanting this wine before serving and serving at a temperature of 64-68 degrees.
